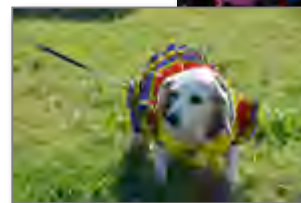

## picking the perfect pet dish

Here's how to get your pet eating in style and safety. You might think any ol' bowl you throw down for your pet would be fine with them, and that's probably true. But what if your cat has digestive issues or your dog's ears are drooping into his food? And wouldn't it be nice if the dishes actually matched your decor? Here's the scoop on what to look for when choosing a pet dining set.

Let's start with the basics:

- Traditional stainless steel bowls are economical, look great in most any kitchen, are easy to clean and keep your pal's drinking water nice and cool. Look for bowls with a rubber rim that'll keep them from tipping and getting nosed around. Plastic bowls can be difficult to clean and can sometimes irritate pet allergies.
- Ceramic bowls are sturdy and come in a wide variety of colors and designs to match any decor. These types often come in handy sets with treat jars as well. But make sure they're dishwasher-safe, unless you're prepared to hand wash these dishes.

### Healthy Eating

- Raised feeders are fantastic. Not only do they also feature some really cool, eye-catching designs, they also aid in digestion, since your dog stands up straighter to eat. This type is also good for bassets and other long-eared breeds, whose ears won't get dirty dragging on the floor — or worse, in their food — as they chow down. Finally, raised feeders are also much easier for older pets with joint or arthritic problems to dine from. If you've got a gulper on your hands, there's a cool new design that just might help. The obstructions in the middle of this dish force dogs or cats to slow their eating down, which reduces gulping, bloating and excessive air intake (which leads to gas). Works with wet and dry food and is a definite conversation starter in your kitchen.
